

HINGHAM PUBLIC LIBRARY MUSEUM PASS POLICY

Only Hingham card holders with library privileges may reserve passes in advance.

Non-Hingham card holders may request passes only on the same day of intended use.

Patrons may use one pass per family per day.

Patrons will be charged a \$2.00 library user fee for each pass. Fee for lost pass is \$10.00.

Reservations may be made up to one month in advance in person, by telephone, or on our website at www.hinghamlibrary.org.

Cancellations or changes in reservations cannot be made online and should be made as far in advance as possible to give other patrons a chance to use the pass. **Patrons who do not notify us of a cancellation are subject to having subsequent reservations denied.**

Passes are normally due back by 8:00 PM on the day the patron uses the pass, unless there is a separate pass for the next day. In this case, the pass may be returned the following day. **Patrons should verify with staff when a particular pass is due.**

If a pass is returned late, causing another patron to miss out on using a pass they had reserved, the person returning the late pass may be charged the rate of \$5.00 per day. Late charges are treated like overdue fines; nonpayment may result in loss of borrowing privileges.
