

## HINGHAM PUBLIC LIBRARY MUSEUM PASS POLICY

Only Hingham residents with library privileges may reserve passes in advance.

Non-Hingham residents may request passes only on the same day of intended use.

Patrons may use one pass per family per day.

Patrons will be charged a \$2.00 library user fee for each pass. Fee for a lost pass is \$10.00.

Reservations may be made up to one month in advance in person, by telephone, or on our website at [www.hinghamlibrary.org](http://www.hinghamlibrary.org).

Cancellations or changes in reservations cannot be made online and should be made as far in advance as possible to give other patrons a chance to use the pass. **Patrons who do not notify us of a cancellation are subject to having subsequent reservations denied.**

Passes are normally due back by closing on the day of use, or by 10:00 AM the following day. **Patrons should verify with staff when a particular pass is due.**

**If a pass is returned late, causing another patron to miss out on using a pass they had reserved, the person returning the late pass may be charged the rate of \$5.00 per day.** Late charges are treated like overdue fines; nonpayment may result in loss of borrowing privileges.

### PASSES AVAILABLE

**Boston by Foot (May–Oct.)**-Free admission, up to 4 people per pass

**Children’s Museum**-Reduced fee admission, \$2.00 per person, up to 4 people per pass

**Institute of Contemporary Art**-Reduced fee admission, \$5.00 per person, up to 2 people per pass

**Museum of Fine Arts**- Reduced fee admission, \$5.00 per person, up to 2 people per pass

**Gardner Museum**-Reduced fee admission, \$5.00 per person, 4 people on weekdays, 2 people on weekends per pass

**Kennedy Library Museum**-Reduced fee admission, \$3.00 per person, up to 2 people per pass

**Mass Dept. of Conservation & Recreation**-Free parking pass, cannot be reserved in advance

**Museum of Science**-Reduced fee admission, \$5.00 per person, up to 4 people per pass

**Plimoth Plantation (Apr–Nov)**-Reduced fee admission, \$10 for adults, \$6 for children ages 6-12, under 6 free, up to 4 people per pass

**World’s End**-Free admission for “one family”

**Zoo New England**-Free admission for 2 adults & 4 children.
